

Narrative Justification:

Following the recent Enterprise Justice 2023 upgrade, it is essential that court staff attend the Tyler Connect Conference to remain current on system changes and to have the opportunity to ask questions directly of Tyler staff. The County Court at Laws will also be initiating a paperless environment during 2026, so it is imperative that we are up to date on how the tasks and queues work within Enterprise Justice. The county will also be adding Defendant Access and Justice Access software from Tyler; these will be entirely new to us. Additionally, the County Clerk’s Office is actively evaluating new OPR and Vitals software; this conference provides a valuable opportunity to view available solutions, ask detailed questions, and speak with other counties currently using these products. The Tyler Connect Conference is the only conference offered by Tyler, and no comparable conferences are available in Texas.

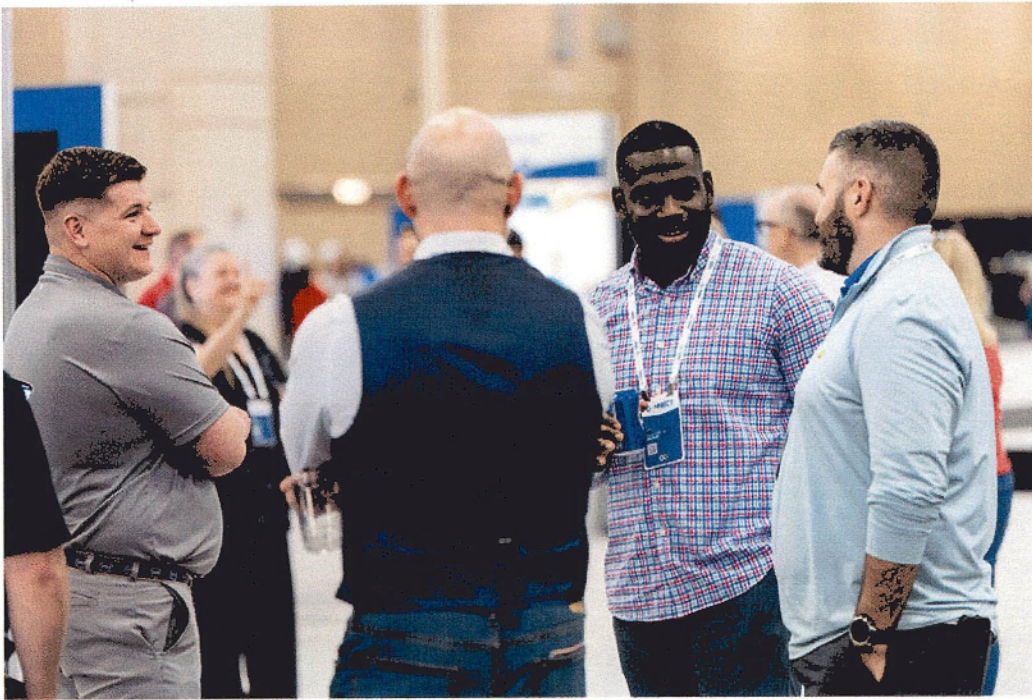

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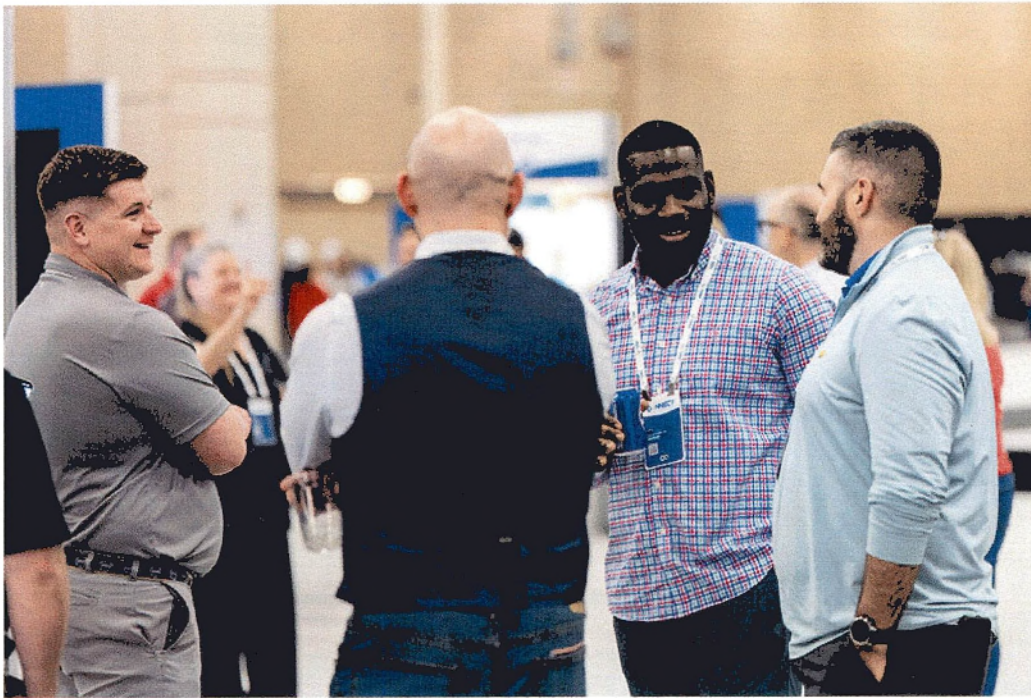


